



Our Bright Spaces are enriching play environments for children impacted by domestic violence, abuse, homelessness, parental imprisonment and ill health.

Inthe UK, there are many children who need our help:

- 1 in 20 has been sexually abused
- 1 in 5 has been exposed to domestic abuse
- More than 200,000 are affected by parental imprisonment
- More than 100,000 are homeless

Our Bright Spaces are designed to help these children recover from trauma, build positive relationships, havefun, learn and relax through play.

We provide the equipment, furniture, toys, games, books, resources and volunteers required to create and sustain Bright Spaces, which are located in domestic violence refuges, homeless shelters, police child protection interview suites, courts, prisons, hospitals and hospices.

Bright Spaces are created in partnership with organisations which include the Metropolitan Police, Refuge, Women's Aid refuges, HM Courts and TribunalsService, HM Prison Service and local charitable organisations.

The Foundation is the registered charity of nursery provider, Bright Horizons Family Solutions which has extensive experience of creating environments for children in its nurseries. The Foundation leverages Bright Horizons' expertise and resources to make a difference in the communities where it operates, and is supported by its employees, clients, suppliers and families.



How Bright Spaces Help

Experiencing trauma can be detrimental to children's physical, emotional and intellectual development. Our Bright Spaces are designed to give children the opportunities they deserve to develop resilience, form stronger bonds with their families and other caring adults, and strengthen their self-esteem.

Every one of our Bright Spaces is special, providing a comforting, peaceful space for children and families who are experiencing distress. We strive to promote healing, offer nurturing and stimulating activities, and provide a stable, enriching environment for each and every child who enters a Bright Space.

A Bright Space in a police station enables a child to relax and feel safe and calm when providing video evidence against the perpetrators of abuse, to help secure convictions.

A Bright Space in a domestic violence refuge provides a safe environment in which children can play freely without the fear of violence or intimidation.

A Bright Space in a prison encourages children to visit and maintain relationships with their families, helping to reduce the risk of re-offending.

A Bright Space in a hospice provides a dedicated place for children and families to create happy memories.

We have more than 80 Bright Spaces throughout the UK, supporting thousands of children. They are used for play and relaxation, therapy, one to one support, family interventions, and child abuse investigation interviews.

"We conducted an interview this week with a young child who had suffered significant abuse. He was given one of the stress packs you supplied us, during the interview he made a comment about the pack in which he stated that if he did not have the things in the bag he would not have coped and would not have been able to speak in the interview.
